News from the HOA Board

HOA assessments are \$225.00 annually due on July 1st and late on July 30th. Payments should be submitted to Advantage Gold Realty c/o River Bluff HOA. The fees are used for lawncare at the front of the housing area, community septic fields, and designated communal areas. Fees are also used to pay the electric bill for the front lights, insurance coverage, attorney fees when collection is required, and postage/mailing expenses.

We have a Facebook page (River Bluff Home Owners Association) for posting news, upcoming events, and sharing information. Homeowners and residents may join, we just ask for adherence to common courtesy.

If residents want to build or add additions to their property, a written request must be submitted to the Board explaining all details, so the Board's Architectural Committee can review the proposal for Restrictive Covenant compliance.



News from the Rhodestown VFD

As of November 1, 2022, the Rhodestown VFD will be running "CPR in progress" calls to assist the Onslow County Emergency Medical Services (EMS). This means faster response times, which saves lives.

Onslow County approved funding to build a new fire station for the Rhodestown VFD on Highway 258 near Hwy 111 allowing entry and exit from both highways. Construction should be completed in October 2023.
