1. Filing fee is \$60. This document must be filed with the Secretary of State.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any officer, director or member of the corporation; and upon dissolution of the corporation the assets thereof shall, after all of its liabilities and obligations have been discharged or adequate provision made therefor, be dedicated to an appropriate public agency to be used for purposes similar to those for which the corporation was created or, in the event that such dedication is refused acceptance, distributed to any association or associations organized for purposes similar to those set forth in Article 3 hereinabove, all as more particularly provided in the bylaws of the corporation.

The corporation may be dissolved only with the assent in writing and signed by all members.
